University of Bengkulu Law School



**Memorandum of Understanding
Between
Thaksin University, Thailand and
University of Bengkulu, Indonesia**

An agreement is signed on this day 4 September 2014, between University of Bengkulu (hereinafter referred to as "UNIB") an institution of higher learning, of Law School of University of Bengkulu, JL. W.R. Supratman Kandang Limun Bengkulu Indonesia on the one part and Thaksin University, (hereinafter referred to as "TSU") an institution of higher learning, of Law school of Thaksin University, Muang District, Songkhla 90000, Thailand on the other.

This is the first MOU between UNIB and TSU in order to promote collaboration between TSU and UNIB, as so the two institutions agree to pursue cooperation in the following five areas whenever it is mutually acceptable and reasonable to do so:

- 1) **Joint Research Programmes**, UNIB & TSU agree to encourage and facilitate staff to develop and participate in collaborative research projects upon mutually direct agreement of the staff from both institutions.
- 2) **Faculty and Student Exchange**, upon mutually satisfactory agreement students and staff shall participate in exchange schemes based on the transfer of knowledge between the two institutions. Details regarding the number of staff and students to participate in the exchange, length of stay, area of study, insurance, accommodation, etc. will be agreed upon after further consultation between the two institutions.
- 3) **Transfer of Knowledge**
UNIB and TSU agree to actively encourage the exchange of expertise, academics, writers, publications, academic materials and information whenever it is feasible to do so.
- 4) **Research Assistance**
UNIB and TSU shall assist one another in the research and publication of original, adapted or translated work that are both relevant and suitable for local and international markets.



5) Cultural Activities

UNIB and TSU shall assist one another in promote link in cultural activities.

In order to promote co-operation and understanding between TSU and UNIB the two institutions agree as follows;

- Both institutions will encourage direct contact and cooperation between their faculty and administrative staff, departments and research institutions.
- UNIB and TSU shall negotiate with each other all procedures and every activity planned or to be carried out under this memorandum of understanding.
- All negotiations regarding work, duration of programmes, and activities must meet mutual agreement between UNIB and TSU before the programme begins.
- Both parties understand that all financial arrangements will have to be negotiated, must meet mutual agreement and will depend on the availability of funds.
- Under no circumstances shall this agreement create any liabilities between UNIB and TSU and shall be deemed as an expression of their intention and desire to cooperate towards the fulfillment of their respective functions.
- The two institutions agree to review this agreement after 5 years from the date hereof.
- This agreement will commence from the date at which both parties affix their signatures.
- Either party may terminate this agreement at any time by mutual consent or by nine months notice in writing.
